Program Description

According to the CDC, there were 659 deaths in North Carolina in 2017 from prescription drug overdose. While the number of opioid related deaths continued to climb in 2017, there was a peak in December of 2017 followed by a slight decline in overdose deaths according to the CDC. The NCMB requires CME for all prescribers who prescribe opioids: "Beginning on July 1, 2017, a physician assistant who prescribes controlled substances shall complete at least two hours of CME from the required 50 hours, designed specifically to address controlled substance prescribing practices." The STOP Act has staggered rollouts of required changes. Are you compliant with the current requirements? Are you prepared for the newest requirements starting January 2020?
